This workshop will offer insights and practical tips on how local and regional governments, in their role as employers, can take to tackle discrimination and achieve equality in the workplace.

The workshop will start with an overview of the activity of CEMR as employers' organisation at European level, in particular concerning the collaboration with the sectoral trade union, EPSU. In the framework of the EU social dialogue, CEMR and EPSU recently adopted two instruments to address discrimination at the workplace: the 'joint guidelines on migration and strengthening anti-discrimination in local and regional governments' and the 'joint guidelines on gender equality'.

The second part of the workshop will be dedicated to an introduction to the report "Gender equality from an employer perspective" issued by SALAR. A presentation of SALAR's gender equality programme from an employer perspective. The programme includes, among other things, eight points that together can increase gender equality at municipalities, county councils and regions.
